- Adding & Subtracting whole numbers

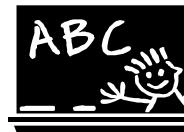


LANGUAGE

History class will also include geography.

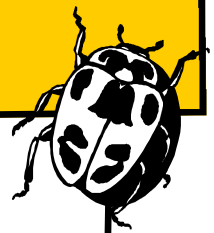
